WITNESSETH, That the said Board has engaged the said Luther Johnson
 as Teacher of School District Number 35 for a term of nine consecutive months
 of the school year 1922 - 1923, said term to begin, unless otherwise agreed upon by the Teacher and the Board on the second
 day of August, 1922, at a salary of \$ 65
 per school month, provided, that neither the School District nor any member of the School District Board shall be liable for any amount of difference
 between the amount of this contract and the amount of the estimate made and approved.

The said teacher agrees to keep him self qualified, and agree in all things to observe the rules and regulations of the District Board,
 also to follow the course of study adopted by the State Board of Education to teach all branches required by law; to keep the daily register of
 the attendance and studies of each pupil belonging to the school; to make all reports desired by the County Superintendent of Public Instruction and
 to preserve in good condition and order the school house, grounds, furniture, apparatus, library, and such other property as may come under the
 immediate supervision of said Teacher.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED, That "Whenever any person shall make and enter into a valid contract with such district board to teach school
 in such district, such contract shall be binding upon such teacher until he has been legally discharged therefrom according to law, or released there-
 from by such district board in regular session; and until such person shall have been thus discharged or released, he shall not have the authority to
 make or enter into any valid contract with any other district board or board of education in the State of Oklahoma to perform services as teacher, or
 instructor for a period of time covered by an existing valid contract which said person has made." - Section 31-1919 School Laws.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED, That the teacher herein employed shall make a full and complete term report to the County Superintendent of
 Public Instruction before receiving pay for the last month of school, and that the board will not approve the claim for the last month's salary until
 said board has received notice from the County Superintendent of Public Instruction that said term report has been received and approved by the
 County Superintendent of Public Instruction.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED, That in the event of the destruction of the school house by accident, fire or otherwise, and if no other suitable
 building can be secured for school purposes this contract shall be void.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED, That in case said Teacher shall be legally dismissed from school or shall have his or her certificate legally
 annulled by expiration or otherwise, then said teacher shall not be entitled to compensation from and after dismissal or annulment of certificate.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED, That the teacher shall become an active member of the County and State Education Associations, attend all
 educational meetings called by the County Superintendent, and cooperate with the County Superintendent in the development of the educational
 interests of the county; and said board agrees not to deduct from the salary of said teacher for any loss of time occasioned by attending any of
 said educational meetings and associations.

 filed in the office of the County Superintendent.

 also to follow the course of study adopted by the State Board of Education to teach all branches required by law; to keep the daily register of
 the attendance and studies of each pupil belonging to the school; to make all reports desired by the County Superintendent of Public Instruction and
 to preserve in good condition and order the school house, grounds, furniture, apparatus, library, and such other property as may come under the
 immediate supervision of said Teacher.

THIS CONTRACT, Entered into this 4 day of Sept, 1926 between
 Atoka County, Oklahoma, by its County Superintendent of Public Instruction acting for said County as provided by
 Article 15, School Laws 1917, and Luther Johnson
 teacher, holding a County
 certificate of the 2nd grade, valid in said County:

WITNESSETH: That the said County in consideration of service hereinafter to be rendered in accordance with
 the provisions herein expressed hereby agrees to pay the said teacher the sum of 90.00 Dollars
 per school month, payable monthly in Separate School Warrants for the school term beginning Oct, 18 1926
 and ending 7 1927, the same to be 7 months more or less as the said County Superintendent
 may direct; and the said Teacher, in consideration of the above named hereby agrees to be bound by all the provisions of
 this contract.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED, That—"Whenever any person shall make and enter into a valid contract with such district
 board to teach school in such district, such contract shall be binding upon such teacher until he has been legally dis-
 charged therefrom according to law, or released therefrom by such district board in regular session; and until such person
 shall have been thus discharged or released, he shall not have the authority to make or enter into any valid contract with
 any other district board or board of education in the State of Oklahoma to perform services as teacher or instructor for a
 period of time covered by an existing valid contract which said person has made."—Section 71-1917 School Laws.

IT IS AGREED by the parties of this Contract that the said County Superintendent shall have authority to desig-
 nate the grade in which said Teacher shall teach, to make whatever changes or transfers he may deem advisable in the
 interest of the school at any time during the school term; to consolidate any two or more rooms; to dispense with the
 teacher at the end of any school month and to prescribe, from time to time, such rules and regulations for the govern-
 ment of said separate school as he may think proper and wise.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED, That said teacher will keep himself qualified, will teach all the branches required
 by law, will follow the Course of Study adopted by the State Board of Education; that he will keep a daily register of
 the attendance and studies of each pupil belonging to the school, will make all reports desired by the said County Superin-
 tendent; that he will preserve in good condition and order the school house, grounds, furniture, apparatus, library and
 such other property as may come under the immediate supervision of said Teacher; that he will be subject to the di-
 rections of the Principal of said school in case a Principal is employed, and in all things be governed and controlled by
 the rules and regulations prescribed by the County Superintendent.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED, That said County Superintendent, acting for the County, shall reserve the right to
 terminate said employment and discharge said Teacher at the end of any school month during the school year, if, in his
 judgment, such action seems necessary for the best interest of the school.

IT IS FURTHER AGREED, That in case said Teacher be legally dismissed from school or shall have his or her
 certificate annulled by expiration, then said Teacher shall not be entitled to compensation from and after such dismissal
 or annulment of certificate.
